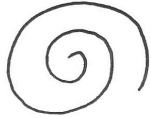


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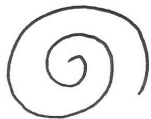


Method

*(aka. how to apply
the scientific method
to becoming a witch!)*

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Here's the single most important thing I've learned from my own journey into witchcraft and by watching new witches start their paths over the last 20 years:

LEARNING REQUIRES DOING

Gathering and collecting information and knowledge is important, but I've noticed so many new witches hesitate to put any of it to use. Sometimes it's fear, sometimes it's overwhelm, sometimes it's uncertainty. But at some point,

IF YOU WANNA BE A WITCH,
YOU GOTTA
DO WITCHCRAFT

Report Conclusions

You do not have to share anything with others if you don't want to. And DON'T be THAT WITCH...

You know, the one who learns a thing and mistakes AN answer for THE ONLY ANSWER and goes around telling other witches they're wrong. But also, don't assume you'll just remember everything forever.

Write it down somewhere.

Share it if you want to.

But absolutely take the time to incorporate this new understanding or skill or method into your practice.

And then...

START THE PROCESS ALL OVER!

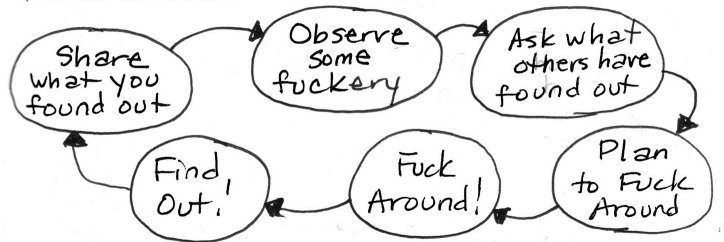


FIND OUT METHOD!

→ (A.K.A. THE SCIENTIFIC METHOD) ←

To be clear, this is NOT to mean there's a whole lot of hard data-driven, evidence-based, absolute fact to be found in magical practice. There isn't. But the process used in science is great for finding what works in YOUR magic.

HOW IT WORKS IN 6 STEPS:



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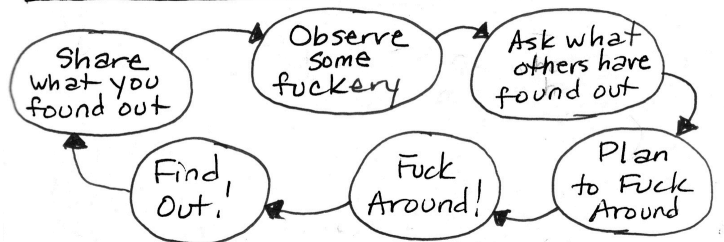


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OBSERVE SOME #1 FUCKERY



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AKA

Analyze Your Data

Don't just do stuff and then not think about it. Look at what happened and figure out what that means for you going forward.

This started with a question. Something you wanted to find out.

So, what did you find out?

Did the outcome surprise you?

Reveal something?

Prove or disprove anything?

Did you make any mistakes?

Would you do anything different?

Did it leave you with more questions?

And don't just deal in binaries, like good/bad or worked/didn't work.

Get into the details.

Get into what it means.

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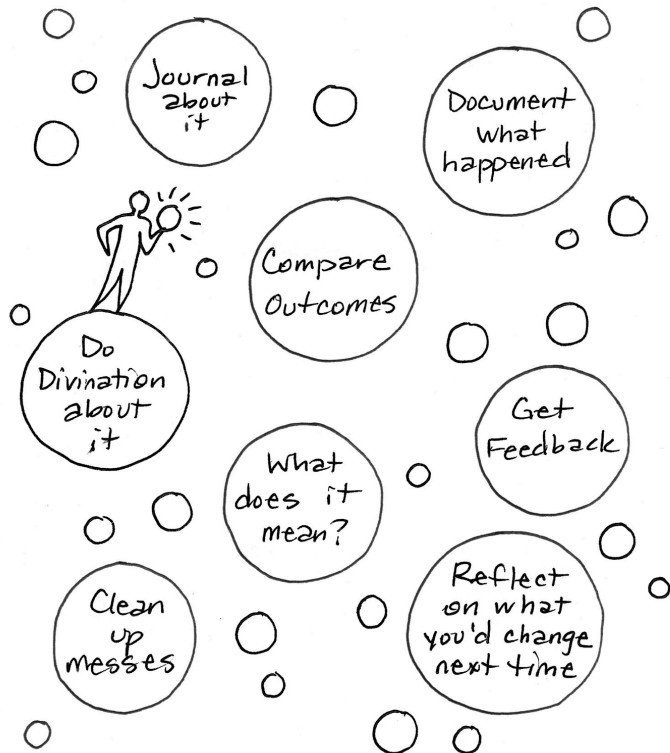
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#5 FIND OUT



AKA

Observe & Question

We all naturally start here: looking around at the wide, magical world we live in. The important part here is to do it. INTENTIONALLY. Think about what you experience, see, feel... And most importantly, ASK QUESTIONS.

Write them down.

Everything you wonder about.

Even the stuff you're afraid is dumb. All the "what would happen if"s. And the "is it okay to"s.

This is where you'll start the process — with a question.

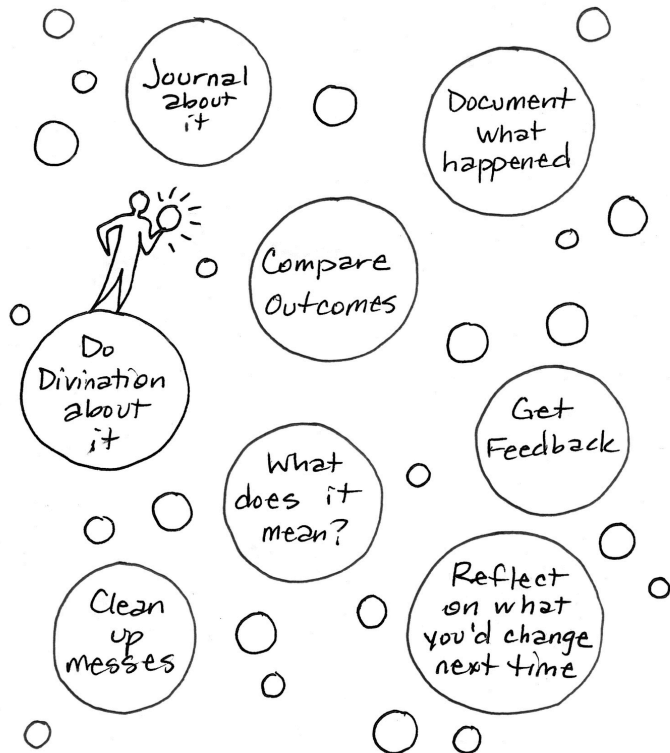
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One you're really curious to answer. Just one, though.

Save the others for later.

(They're a good start to a grimoire, btw...)

Test With an Experiment

Time to jump in and do magic!

You planned it, now do it!

You posed a question, now answer it!

The important thing here is to not be hung up on everything turning out the way you expect or hope.

That's the thing about experimentation — you just want a result, not a specific result. YOU LEARN SOMETHING EITHER WAY!

This is where you can have some fun with your magic. Do spells for inconsequential stuff so you know if and how they work when you do them for important purposes.

I can't stress enough how important the act of actually DOING SOMETHING really is.

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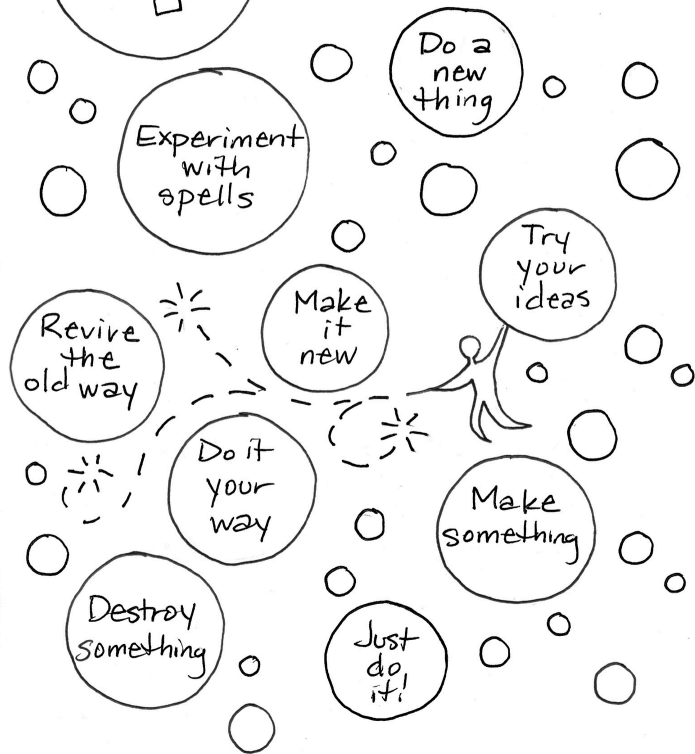

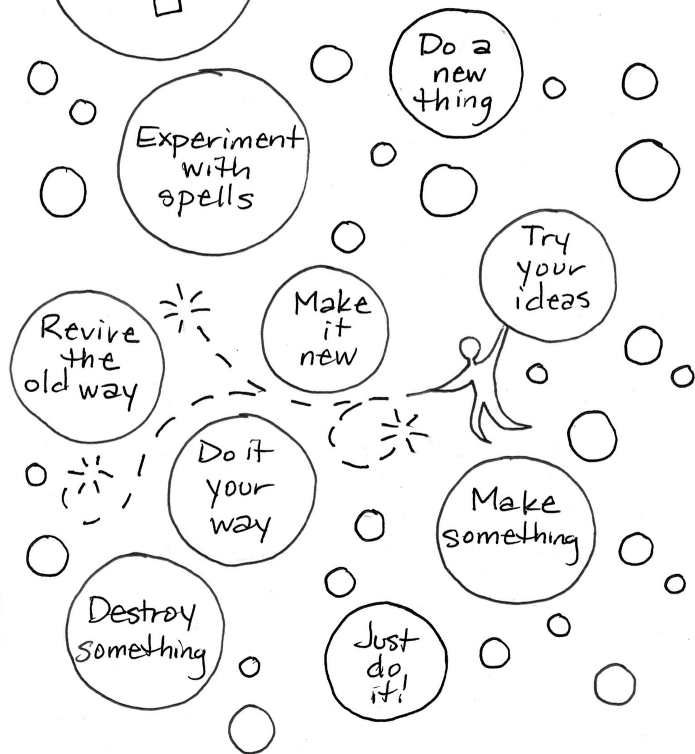
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Research the Topic

Here is the step where a lot of people stop, which is a big mistake.
Don't look for the answer.
Don't look for an answer.
Find all the answers.
As much knowledge as you can put your hands on. Different viewpoints and approaches, contradicting opinions, lore and history, everything.
The point is to gain understanding of the topic within all the context in which it exists — not so you become an expert, but so you can move on to the next part of the process.
Yeah, the actual fucking around part!
Don't take any of what you learn at face value just yet.
You're just drawing a map so you can plot a path forward.

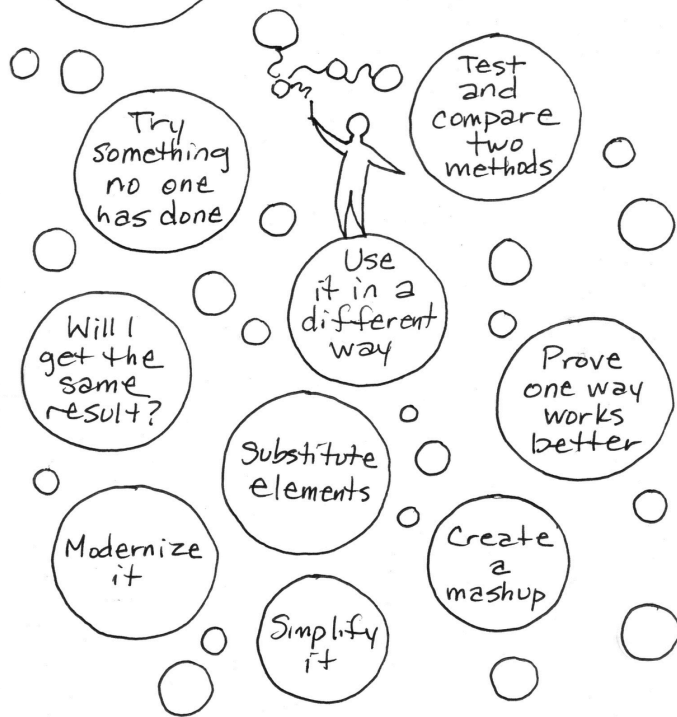

Develop a Hypothesis

Decide how, exactly, you want to fuck around and what you'll need to do so. We've all got our own styles.

I like coming up with new ways to do spells or workings and trying them out, just to see what happens.

Maybe you like to find ancient spells and see if they still work now.

Maybe you just want to prove something works.

Or that it doesn't work.

Maybe do two spells for similar things and see which works better.

The point is to look at your research and choose to DO SOMETHING.

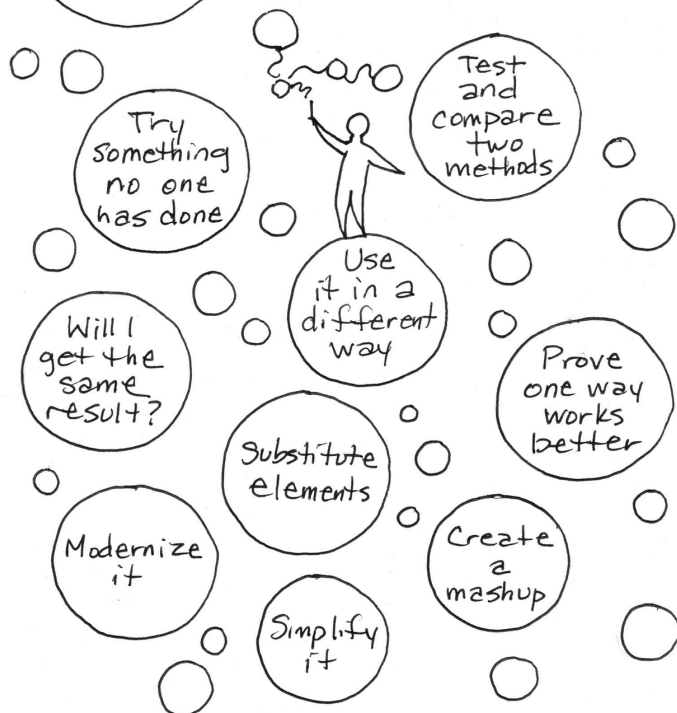
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Do something to see what the outcome will be.
