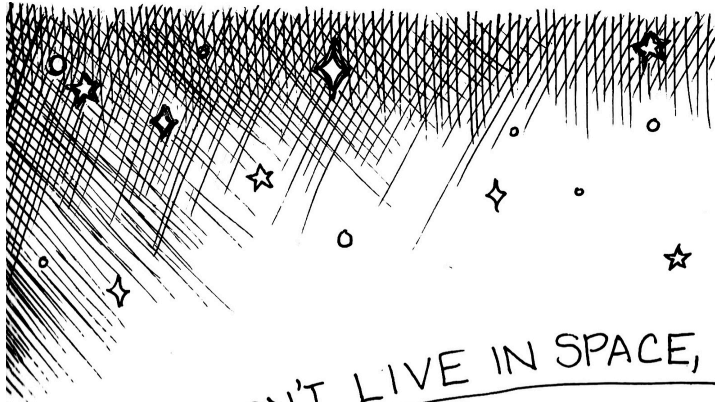
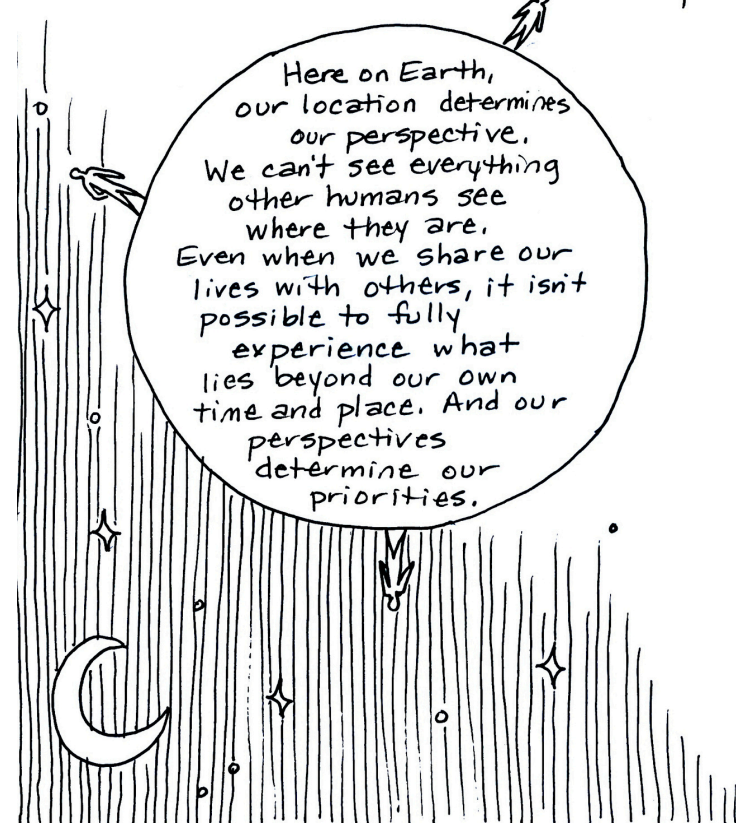


BUT WE DON'T LIVE IN SPACE,
